

Swimming at Roundhill Academy from September 2020



We are so excited to welcome you back to the pool. As with many things in life, there are some new procedures that you need to be aware of at the venue. This document summarises all of those changes.

Arrival time

Please do not arrive any earlier than 10 minutes before your lesson starts. This should give you enough time to get changed and prevents lots of people from waiting around in spaces which may be too small to handle it in the current situation.

Arriving swim-ready

Wherever possible, you and your child should arrive as swim ready as possible at the venue i.e. with your swimming costume/trunks on underneath your clothes ready to change poolside. This is because the changing rooms will only be accessible for a **maximum of 15 minutes** after your class for those parents who have been in the water with their child to ensure maximum occupancy in the changing rooms is not exceeded.

Spectators

We will be operating a 'no spectators' policy for the time being at this venue and would ask that only 1 adult per child accompanies your child to their lesson. If your child goes into the water on their own (SA Level 3, 4 and 6 only) you will need to wait outside the poolside exit doors or in your car if the weather is poor during their lesson. You can still enter the pool hall with your child to help with changing before and after their lesson as required but must wear a face covering.

If you require assistance due to a disability (either your own disability or your child's), then you are able to bring a spectator to help as necessary.

By not allowing additional spectators, we are able to practice social distancing more effectively.

Parking at the venue

There are no changes to the parking at this venue.

Entering the building

Please enter the building via usual door and sanitise hands on entry. You will need to wear a face covering when entering the venue and this should be removed once you are changed and ready to enter the pool. Please do not enter the building until 10 minutes before your class is due to start.



Toilets

Toilets are available at this venue within the changing rooms. Please wash hands before and after use.

Changing rooms

Ladies and Gents Changing rooms are available at this venue for classes where both parent and child are in the water **together** (SA Level 1 and 2) The showers are NOT in use within the changing rooms but can be used for changing to help maintain social distancing. Swimmers/Parents will have access to the changing rooms for a maximum of 10 minutes before and 15 minutes after their class. There will be antibacterial wipes available for you to use within the changing rooms on the benching after you have used it.

Entering the pool area

Please wait poolside on the RH side of the pool, keeping socially distant from other customers and pool users wherever possible, until the teacher indicates it is time for you to enter the pool.

Exiting the pool area after your lesson

Please exit using the ladder steps indicated by the teacher and walk anticlockwise around the pool to get back to the changing area. Showers are NOT available at this venue. If your child swims in the pool on their own, we ask for them to get changed poolside after their class. If you have been in the water with your child changing rooms are available to you for a **maximum of 15 minutes** after your class has finished in order that we can clean before the next class arrives so please ensure you vacate the changing rooms as quickly as possible. We advise that you bring easy, comfortable clothing for both you and your child – items like onesies might be easiest for children to get changed quickly and keep them warm.

Leaving the building

When you are ready to leave the building, please exit via the emergency exit doors at the far end of poolside back to your car/mode of transport.
